ORDINANCE NO. # 93-137

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS TO BE SEATED PURSUANT TO ELECTION OR APPOINTED AFTER NOVEMBER 20, 1993, PURSUANT TO THE SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted the Act of June 14, 1957, P.L. 304, Section 1, as amended, 53 P.S. 65515 also known as the Second Class Township Code setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of Supervisors of Townships of the Second Class, and;

WHEREAS, said Act provides that Supervisors of Townships having a population of 5,000 to 9,999 shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the population of Amity Township is 6,434; and

WHEREAS, the said Act authorizes the Board of Supervisors of the various Townships of the Second Class to determine the compensation of Supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in said Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors of Amity Township to establish the compensation for Supervisors pursuant to the maximum rate of compensation with regard to a Township with a population of 5,000 to 9,999.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby Enacted and Ordained as follows:

1. Each Supervisor of Amity Township seated to serve a term pursuant to election or appointed to office on or after November 20, 1993, shall receive compensation for performance of their duties and responsibilities at the maximum rate of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) per year.

2. No Supervisor shall receive annual compensation under this Ordinance in excess of the annual statutory limit permitted by the said Act for Supervisors of Townships within the appropriate population category, exclusive of such reimbursements and other benefits as are permitted in accordance with the said Act.

3. Such compensation shall be paid in quarterly installments.

4. All other Ordinances inconsistent herewith are specifically not applicable with regard to Supervisors seated to serve a term pursuant to election or appointed after November 20, 1993, but the terms and conditions of any prior and validly enacted Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect with regard to Supervisors seated to serve a term pursuant to election or appointed prior to November 21, 1993, and who are still serving a part, portion, or balance of that term.

5. The Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days from the date of adoption

Adopted this 29th day of November, 1993, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Amity Township Board of Supervisors.
