

ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE NAMING OF STREETS,
ROADS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF AMITY, BERKS
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Amity, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. The words "streets", "roads" and "highways" shall mean the whole or any part of any public right-of-way for travel whether or not in a sub-division or built-up community.

SECTION 2. All streets, roads and highways within the Township of Amity, Berks County, Pennsylvania, are hereby named in accordance with the names set forth on the official road map of the Township of Amity, Berks County, Pennsylvania, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and referred to as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 3. Prior approval of the Board of Supervisors shall be obtained before the erection of any sign identifying a street.

SECTION 4. If any section or part of any section of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any other part of this Ordinance; it is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been enacted had such invalid section, or portion of a section, not have been included herein.

SECTION 5. All other Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such inconsistency may exist.
