

ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF AMITY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION OR DUMPING OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH
AND REFUSE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

ARTICLE I. BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Amity, Berks County, Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person, association, firm or corporation shall keep or suffer to remain upon his or her premises, or on any private property, any garbage, rubbish, offal, carcass, putrid matter or other offensive or unwholesome matter (farming manure excepted), or cast the same upon any highway, road, lot or piece of ground within the Township. Nor may any person, firm or corporation use or permit to be used any spot or place within the Township as a public or private dump for garbage, refuse or rubbish.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, before a Justice of the Peace, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for a period of not more than fifteen (15) days; PROVIDED: each day's continuance of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
