

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF AMITY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
OPENING AS A PUBLIC TOWNSHIP ROAD, PART OF GRIFFITH BOULEVARD
IN THE DEVELOPMENT KNOWN AS AMITY GARDENS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of Amity Township, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1 - That there is hereby opened as public township road part of Griffith Boulevard as shown on part of Plan of Amity Gardens, and recorded in Plan Book 20, page 10, A, B, C and D, said road being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING on the northerly right-of-way line of the west bound lane of State Highway Route 422 and having a roadbed, including an island to separate north bound traffic from south bound traffic on Griffith Boulevard, at the intersection with State Highway Route 422, of 76' and 12' sidewalk area on each side, and continuing in a northwardly direction and funnelling into a roadbed of 36' at a point 414.58' northwardly from the said northerly right-of-way line of State Highway Route 422; thence still in a northwardly direction and maintaining a road bed of 36' and 12' side walk area on each side for a distance of 200' including the intersection of Welsh Drive and Harvey Avenue, each a 53' wide street intersecting with Griffith Boulevard being the extent of the herein described Griffith Boulevard as shown on Mast Engineering Company, Inc. Plan #B-2657-39, which is on file in the Township Supervisors' office.

SECTION 2 - All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
