

ORDINANCE NO. 8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF AMITY, BERKS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, OPENING AS A PUBLIC TOWNSHIP ROAD RICHARDS AVENUE,
MERRITT AVENUE AND NICHOLSON AVENUE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF
SUNRISE HILLS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of Amity Township, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1 - That there is hereby opened to a width of thirty-three feet (33') as a public township road all of Richards Avenue, Merritt Avenue and Nicholson Avenue, as shown on the Plan of Sunrise Hills, said Plan being dated July 1956, and also being on file in the Township Supervisors' office, and approved December 1, 1956, said roads being more particularly described as follows:

(a) All of Richards Avenue, beginning on the western side of and at its intersection with the Macadam State Highway leading from Douglassville to Yellow House; thence extending in a westwardly direction, a distance of 540 feet[±], as shown on the plan of Sunrise Hills, recorded in Plan Book Volume 20, page 15, Berks County records, at Reading, Pennsylvania.

(b) All of Merritt Avenue, beginning at the northern side of and at its intersection with Richards Avenue; thence extending in a northeastwardly direction to the intersection of Nicholson Avenue, as shown on the plan of Sunrise Hills, recorded in Plan Book Volume 20, page 15, Berks County Records, at Reading, Pennsylvania.

(c) All of Nicholson Avenue, beginning on the western side of and at its intersection with the Macadam State Highway leading from Douglassville to Yellow House; thence in a westwardly direction, a distance of 445 feet[±], as shown on the plan of Sunrise Hills, recorded in Plan Book Volume 20, page 15, Berks County records.

SECTION 2 - All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
