

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE VACATING IN WHOLE OR IN PART CERTAIN STRIPS OF ROAD LOCATED WHOLLY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF AMITY, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DESIGNATED ON THE AMITY TOWNSHIP ROAD SYSTEM AS ROUTES NO. 416-625-622-464-466-628-355-634-633 AND REMOVING SAID STRIPS OF ROAD FROM THE TOWNSHIP'S ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the strips of road hereafter designated are located wholly within the Township of Amity, Berks County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, their locations are set forth and described by route numbers on the Amity Township Road System; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Amity, Berks County, Pennsylvania, consider it to be in the public interest and welfare that said hereafter designated strips of road be vacated and removed from the Township Road System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township of Amity in the County of Berks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same in accordance with Section 1101 of the second class township code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

That the following described strips of road located wholly within Amity Township, be vacated and removed from the Township Road System and the same are hereby vacated and removed from the Township Road System and the same are hereby vacated and removed from the Township Road System, VIZ:

1. Amity Township Route No. 416 beginning at an intersection with U. S. Route No. 422; thence for a centerline S. 56⁰ W. a distance of 890 feet more or less to the Schuylkill River. Bound by lands of the St. Gabriel's Episcopal Church of Douglassville and the Colonial Trust Co. of Philadelphia, Pa.

2. Amity Township Route No. 625 beginning at an intersection with Berks County Road in Douglassville formerly the Perkiomen and Reading Turnpike; thence for a centerline S. 80⁰ W. a distance of 620 feet more or less to the Schuylkill River. Bound by lands of Mr. & Mrs. Verdon Hummel, Douglassville, R.D. #1, Mr. & Mrs. Roy H. Schurr, Douglassville, R.D. #1, and the Mrs. Charles Geiger Estate, Douglassville, R.D. #2.

3. Amity Township Route No. 622 beginning at an intersection with Pennsylvania Route No. 562 (A1031); thence for a centerline N. 82⁰ E. a distance of 59 feet more or less. Bound by lands of Mr. & Mrs. Charles Trumbore, Earlville, Pa.

4. Amity Township Route No. 464 beginning at an intersection with Pennsylvania Legislative Route No. 06179; thence for a centerline S. 19⁰ W. a distance of 365 feet more or less; thence S. 36⁰ E. a distance of 180 feet more or less; thence S. 19⁰ W. a distance of 460 feet more or less to the Schuylkill River. Bound by lands of Mr. & Mrs. Russell L. Trace, Monocacy, Pa. and Mr. Albert Amole, Birdsboro, R.D. #2, Pa.

5. Amity Township Route No. 466 beginning at an intersection with the Oley Township line; thence S. 20⁰ W. a distance of 1290 feet more or less across Pennsylvania Route No. 562 (LR 06110) to Amity Township Route No. 460. Bound by lands of Mr. & Mrs. Henry Eyrich, Oley, Pa.

6. Amity Township Route No. 628 beginning at the intersection of Amity Township Route No. 632; thence S. 14⁰ W. a distance of 148 feet more or less. Bound by lands of Mr. & Mrs. Robert Spotts, Douglassville, R.D. #2, Pa., and Mr. & Mrs. Russell Spotts, Douglassville, R.D. #2, Pa.

7. Amity Township Route No. 355 beginning at the intersection of Berks County Road, formerly Perkiomen and Reading Turnpike, thence S. 40⁰ W. a distance of 560 feet more or less to the Schuylkill River. Bound by lands of Mr. & Mrs. Howard Wynn, Douglassville, R. D. #1, Pa.

8. Amity Township Route No. 634 beginning at the intersection of Pennsylvania Route No. 562 (A 1031); thence S. 51⁰ W. a distance of 540 feet more or less to Amity Township Route No. 628. Bound by lands of Mr. Robert Merritt, Douglassville, R.D. #2, Pa.

Amity Township Route No. 633 beginning at the intersection of Amity Township Route No. 628; thence S. 68⁰ E. a distance of 140 feet more or less to Amity Township Route No. 634. Bound by lands of Mr. Robert Merritt, Douglassville, R.D. #2, Pa.
