The Amity Township Board of Supervisors hereby notifies the public that an Official Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan for Amity Township is on file at the Township Municipal Building. The Township is considering the Plan for adoption. The public is invited to review the Plan and submit written comments to the Township of the following address: Amity Township Board of Supervisors, 2004 Weaverstown Road, Douglassville, PA 19518. The plan investigates sewage disposal issues for the portion of the Township that is currently served by public sewer. An in-depth study was conducted at the Bel Air Estates, Mobile Home Park area. This area was identified as needing a public sewer solution to resolve existing problems. The sewage facilities alternatives that were investigated for this area were: extension of conventional sewer along Limekin Road, with connection to the Amity Township Sewage Treatment Plant; extension of conventional sewer along Monocacy Creek to serve Bel Air Estates and the Valley Road area, with connection to the Amity Township Sewage Treatment Plant; construction of a collection system and an on-lot sewage disposal system serving Bel Air Estates and the Valley Road area, and discharging into the Monocacy Creek; and construction of a community on-lot sewage disposal system serving Bel Air Estates.
