

RESOLUTION NO. 8-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF AMITY,
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,

BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Amity Township Board of Supervisors as follows:


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Amity Township recognizes the need to require and regulate the proof of hauler for municipal waste. While Amity Township Resolution Number 07-24 regulates the collection, the Township desires to require all parties to maintain proof of contract with collector/hauler to dispose of municipal waste generated on the premises for one year. Whenever requested by Amity Township, the owner of real estate shall present proof of current contract with a licensed hauler.


RESOLVED, that the Pursuant to Ordinance 91-127, the Board of Supervisors may establish rules and regulations from time to time regulating the collection of municipal waste and recyclables, and hereby requires all property owners, stakeholders, and residents to contract with a bonafide trash hauler for the legal disposal of solid waste other than identified recyclables established by Amity Township and that such owner of real estate, whenever requested by Amity Townhi, shall present proof of current contract with a licensed hauler.


