

RESOLUTION No. 10-05

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PARTICIPATION ALONG WITH OTHER SOUTHEASTERN PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPALITIES FOR LEGAL, ENGINEERING AND LEGISLATIVE SERVICE FOR STORMWATER REGULATORY SUPPORT.

WHEREAS, First Class Townships, Second Class Townships and Boroughs, when not inconsistent with state or federal law, are authorized to oversee and regulate trade, commerce, and the use of public streets, ways and property within their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the First Class Township, Second Class Township and Borough Codes, as well as the provisions of Pennsylvania's Intergovernmental Cooperation Law, provide for intergovernmental cooperation between and among municipalities in the exercise or performance of their respective governmental functions, powers, and responsibilities and authorize joint agreements as may be deemed appropriate for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Participating Municipalities in the Montgomery County Consortium of Communities have determined that it is in the best interests of their resident to cooperate in obtaining legal, engineering and legislative services to assist them in assessing the legal and regulatory impacts and implications of the proposed new MS4 permit (PAG-13) and the associated state generated model storm water management ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Participating Municipalities hereby agree and commit to share on a pro-rata (population) basis, based on population, the total sum of \$100,000 in projected costs for all legal, engineering and legislative services needed to coordinate their comments regarding the impacts of these programs upon their communities to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection and their elected officials as appropriate, in the best interests of their residents.


