

**AMITY TOWNSHIP**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 10-06**

**RESOLUTION OF THE SUPERVISORS OF AMITY TOWNSHIP**, Berks County,  
Pennsylvania (hereinafter “the municipality”).

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the “Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act,” as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, ARRO Consulting, the consulting engineer for Amity Township, has prepared a plan which provides for sewage facilities in Amity Township, and the alternative of choice selected by the municipality is enlargement of the sewage treatment capacity with certain provisions as set forth in the plan. The municipality is committed to implement the plan within the time limits established therein; and

**WHEREAS**, Amity Township finds that the plan conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans, and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Supervisors of the Township of Amity hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the “Official Plan” of the municipality, the above-referenced Facility Plan. The municipality

hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).
